Denmark: Draft Resolution Concerning Economic, Social
and Cultural Rights

The Commission on Human Rights

Reaffirming its conviction that protection of human rights in the modern world is incomplete without effective measures which secure to everyone the enjoyment of economic, social and cultural rights as set forth in articles 22-27 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights;

Taking note of the survey prepared by the Secretary-General regarding the activities of other bodies of the United Nations and of the Specialized Agencies in matters within the scope of the said articles;

Considering the significance of measures already taken or planned to be taken by such bodies and by the Specialized Agencies, as well as the desirability of promoting and supplementing their activities;

Decides to devote an essential part of its future work to the study of measures by which the enjoyment of economic, social and cultural rights can most effectively be secured to everyone through joint and separate action by Member States in accordance with articles 55 and 56 of the Charter.
