## **Biennial evaluation plan for the Trade sub-programme for the biennium 2012–2013**

## Note by the secretariat

## Summary

This note provides the logical framework for the biennial performance evaluation for 2012-2013 of the UNECE Trade Sub-programme. It establishes links between the expected accomplishments (EA) and indicators of achievement (IA) of the Strategic Framework and the more detailed clusters of the biennial Programme of Work. The Subprogramme has three main areas of work:

- Adoption and increased implementation by Member States of ECE recommendations, norms, standards, guidelines and tools for trade facilitation and electronic business;
- Adoption by Member States of ECE recommendations, norms, standards, guidelines and tools for regulatory cooperation;
- Adoption and increased implementation by Member States of ECE recommendations, norms, standards, guidelines and tools for agricultural quality standards.

For the purposes of the biennial evaluation, these areas are disaggregated into seven clusters of activities under the biennial Programme of Work.

The Committee is invited to endorse the evaluation plan.
