INFORMATION NOTICE NO. 2

Introduction

At the invitation of the Government of Slovakia a Workshop will be organized at Bratislava from 13 to 15 May 1997 on "The Role of Enhancement of Utilization of Primary and Secondary Hydro Potential in the Context of Environmental Protection".

This Information Notice contains guidelines on the presentation of papers and information on participation in and arrangements for the Workshop.

I. PURPOSE OF THE WORKSHOP

The purpose of the Workshop is to consider the importance of hydro power generation in the context of ecological and economic parameters and to exchange views on modelling of financial aspects of hydro-power generation projects, as well as related issues at the design and operational stages. The Workshop will also discuss possibilities of international cooperation in this regard.

II. SPONSORSHIP AND VENUE

The Workshop is convened under the auspices of the Ministry of Economy of Slovakia, in cooperation with Slovenské Elektrárne a.s. (SE), with the Slovak National Committee of the World Energy Council, and with the Working Party on Electric Power of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (ECE).

III. TOPICS TO BE CONSIDERED

- Role of hydro-energy in energy economy: present situation and prospects for the development of large hydro power plants.
- Environmental impacts of hydro power plants and related environmental impact assessment (EIA).
- Rational use of hydro-electrical potential in the light of new concepts for environmental protection and progress in technologies. Modernization and ecologization of existing hydro-electric power stations.
- Financing models of hydro-energy investments.

IV. DOCUMENTATION AND PREPARATION OF PAPERS

The working language of the Workshop will be English and simultaneous interpretation will be provided in Slovak. All documentation and papers prepared by national experts and experts from international organizations should be in English.

Authors are invited to transmit to the ECE secretariat and organizers two camera-ready copies of their papers of not more than 4,000 words prepared in English to the secretariat and organizers by 15 March 1997 to be reproduced by the organizers and to be available at the Workshop (Diskettes in WordPerfect would be appreciated). Authors unable to meet this deadline are requested to send 70 copies of their papers to the organizers to be available to the participants.

V. PARTICIPATION

Participants are invited to return the completed final registration form (annex) to the secretariat and organizers by 15 April 1997.

All participants should be in possession of a valid passport or an equivalent document. Entry visas, where applicable, should be obtained from the diplomatic representation of Slovakia in the country of origin or residence.
