LETTER DATED 27 MARCH 1984 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instruction from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the sad news that due to the severity of his injuries Hassan Ibrahimi, one of the victims of the Iraqi chemical warfare attained martyrdom at Carlinskan Hospital in Stockholm on 5 March 1984. The second victim, Ali Sorjani, 19 years old, too, passed away for the same ailment at Upsalaye Hospital in Stockholm on Friday, 9 March 1984.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter could be circulated as a document of the Security Council so that it might appreciate the significance of its deadly silence vis à vis the Iraqi crimes.
