CABLECTAM DATED 18 SEPTEMBER 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF TRAC, TO THE SECRETARY-GRIERAL

AT A TIME WHEN PEACE-LOVING STATES UNANIMOUSLY DEPIONE AGGRESSION AND CALL FOR THE RESPECT OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHAPTER AND THE PESCULTIONS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, ISRAEL COES ON TO ADD ANOTHER ACT OF AGGRESSION TO THE SERIES OF ITS AGGRESSIVE ACTS AGAINST THE ARAB COUNTRIES IN VIOLATING THE INTECRITY OF THE FRONTIERS OF THE HASHINITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN AND OCCUPYING A BART OF ITS TERRITORY AND THUS COMMITTING A SERICUS ACT WHICH THREATENS PEACE IN THE MIDDLE LAST. THE COVERNMENT OF IRAG BOUND TO JORDAN BY STRONG BROTEERLY TIES IN ADDITION TO THE TREATY OF ALLIANCE PETWEEN THEM CANNOT REMAIN UNCONCERNED TOWARD THE SAID AGGRESSION THE CONSEQUENCES OF WHICH WILL FALL ON THE OFFENDING IGRAEL. IRAG SUPPORTS THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HASHINITE KINCDOM OF JORDAN IN ITS COMPLAINT COMMUNICATED TO YOU AND I REQUEST IN THE NAME AND ON BEHALF OF MY GOVERNMENT THAT YOU BE GOOD ENOUGH TO BRING THIS TO THE NOTICE OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, IN ORDER THAT APPROPRIATE MEASURES MAY BE TAKEN FOR COMPELLING THE JEWISH FORCES TO WITHDRAW TO THEIR PRECEDING LINE.
