CABLEGRAM DATED 18 SEPTEMBER 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
OF IRAQ TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

AT A TIME WHEN PEACE-LOVING STATES UNANIMOUSLY DEPLORE AGGRESSION AND CALL FOR THE RESPECT OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER AND THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, ISRAEL GOES ON TO ADD ANOTHER ACT OF AGGRESSION TO THE SERIES OF ITS AGGRESSIVE ACTS AGAINST THE ARAB COUNTRIES IN VIOLATING THE INTEGRITY OF THE FRONTIERS OF THE HASHIMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN AND OCCUPYING A PART OF ITS TERRITORY AND THUS COMMITTING A SERIOUS ACT WHICH THREATENS PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST. THE GOVERNMENT OF IRAQ BOUND TO JORDAN BY STRONG BROTHERLY TIES IN ADDITION TO THE TREATY OF ALLIANCE BETWEEN THEM CANNOT REMAIN UNCONCERNED TOWARD THE SAID AGGRESSION THE CONSEQUENCES OF WHICH WILL FALL ON THE OFFENDING ISRAEL. IRAQ SUPPORTS THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HASHIMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN IN ITS COMPLAINT COMMUNICATED TO YOU AND I REQUEST IN THE NAME AND ON BEHALF OF MY GOVERNMENT THAT YOU BE GOOD ENOUGH TO BRING THIS TO THE NOTICE OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, IN ORDER THAT APPROPRIATE MEASURES MAY BE TAKEN FOR COMPELLING THE JEWISH FORCES TO WITHDRAW TO THEIR PRECEDING LINE.
