LETTER DATED 31 JULY 1986 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, and further to the letter addressed to you by Mr. Tar in Aziz, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs (5/18243 of 28 July 1986), I have the honour to inform you that the Iranian régime is continuing to bombard purely civilian targets.

I should be grateful if you would have this document and its annex distributed as a document of the Security Council.

Annex

1. On 29 July 1986, the evil enemy bombarded residential auarters in the intrepid city of Basrah, using long-range artillery. The enemy bombardment resulted in the death of one civilian citizen, the wounding of three others and damage to three dwell ing-houses.

Three **enemy** aircraft crossed our international frontiers **in** Arbil and Sulaymaniyah governerates, their target **being** residential quarters. **The** incident resulted in **the** wounding of three civilian citizens and **damage to** four civilian bicycles **and** three caravans in Arbil qovernerate **and the wounding of two other** civilian citizens in Sulaymaniyah governerate.

2. On 30 July 1986, the forces of the iniquitous enemy bombarded residential awarters in the steadfastly resisting city of Basrah, using long-range artillery. The bombardment resulted in the death of one child, the wounding of 13 citizens, including five children, and damage to one dwelling-house.

The forces of the unjust party also bomharded the Ramai housing complex helonging to Halabjah district, and the incident resulted in the death of one woman.

At 2.13 p.m. on 30 July, two enemy aircraft crossed our international frontiers in the northern sector, their target being residential auarters in the town of Sulaymaniyah. This resulted in the wounding of two civilian citizens.
