

Letter dated 24 March 2014 from the Chair of the Central African Republic configuration of the Peacebuilding Commission addressed to the President of the Security Council

In my capacity as Chair of the Central African Republic configuration of the Peacebuilding Commission, I visited Bangui from 4 to 7 March 2014. During this first visit, I held discussions with different stakeholders to seek their views on the priority aspects for the engagement of the Peacebuilding Commission in the Central African Republic in the light of the current political and security situation. The report of the visit is attached, for your consideration.*

I would like to thank the transitional authorities of the Central African Republic for their warm welcome, Special Representative of the Secretary-General, Babacar Gaye, and his Office for all their assistance and continued support, and the Peacebuilding Support Office for its timely and substantive advice and support.

In the meantime, I remain at the disposal of the Security Council to provide further information and clarifications as may be required. The Peacebuilding Commission configuration is ready to accompany the Central African Republic and to inform the Council on developments relevant to peacebuilding, as appropriate.

I kindly request that the present letter be issued as a document of the Security Council.
