Examples of arrangements of the GHS label elements

A6.1 Example 1



The product is a liquid substance:

- classified under GHS as skin corrosive category 1B and flammable liquid category 3.
- UN Model Regulations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods classification is corrosive liquid, flammable, N.O.S., - UN 2920.

A6.1.1 *Label for large receptacle (200 litre drum) for transport, emergency response and workplace audiences*
