Explanatory Notes

Item 1 Adoption of the agenda

According to the Commission's Rules of Procedure, the first decision to be taken on the provisional agenda shall be the adoption of the agenda.

Item 2 Election of officers

According to the Commission's Rules of Procedure and established practice, the Meeting of Experts is expected to elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman. The forty-fourth session of the Meeting of Experts unanimously re-elected Mr. F. Monastra (Italy) as Chairman and Mr. W. Staub (Germany) as Vice-Chairman. Due to the sudden death of Mr. Monastra, the Meeting of Experts should elect a new Chairman.

Item 3 Matters of interest arising since the forty-fourth session

Document TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/2 presents matters of interest to the work of the Meeting of Experts.

Item 4 Working Papers on the Alignment of UN/ECE Standards with the Standard Layout

At its forty-fourth session, the Meeting of Experts requested the Rapporteur (Turkey) to prepare a revised version of the Standards for Inshell Hazelnuts and Hazelnut Kernels including the decisions taken at that session. (documents TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/3 and TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/4)

Item 5 Consideration of UN/ECE Recommendations

- a. <u>Cashew Kernels</u>: This Recommendation was adopted by the Working Party in November 1996 for a two year trial period which will end in November 1998. Delegates are invited to consider whether the present text (document TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/5) should be adopted as a new standard or whether further changes would be necessary. Document TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/6 contains comments submitted by the delegation of India concerning the UN/ECE Recommendation on Cashew Kernels.
- b. <u>Walnut Kernels</u>: This revised version of the UN/ECE Standard for Walnut Kernels was adopted by the Working Party in November 1996 as a Recommendation for a two year trial period which will end in November 1998. Delegates are invited to consider whether the present text (document TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/7) should be adopted as a new standard or whether further changes would be necessary. A proposal by the US delegation is contained in document TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/8.

c. <u>Dried Apples</u>: At its fifty-first session (1995), the Working Party had adopted the Draft Standard for Dried Apples as a UN/ECE Recommendation for a two year trial period; this period was extended for a further year in November 1997. The trial period will end in November 1998 and delegations are invited to consider whether the present text, prepared by the Rapporteur, Romania, should be adopted as a new standard or whether further changes would be necessary. (TRADE/WP.7/GE.2/1998/9)

Item 6 Revision of the Standard Layout for Dry and Dried Produce

AGRI/WP.1/GE.2/R.96 (already submitted to the Meeting of Experts in 1997) presents a proposal by the US delegation to revise the UN/ECE Standard Layout for Dry and Dried Fruit.

Item 7 Discussion on the UN/ECE Recommendation on Inshell Walnuts

At its fifty-third session (November 1997), the Working Party adopted the revisions to the Standard for Inshell Walnuts for a two year trial period and re-iterated discussion on the proposal by the US delegation (document TRADE/WP.7/1998/GE.2/10) to the Meeting of Experts.

Item 8 Discussion on the UN/ECE Standards for Unshelled Pistachio Nuts and
Decorticated, and Decorticated Peeled Pistachio Nuts

Document TRADE/WP.7/1998/GE.2/11 presents the proposal by the US delegation to discuss the UN/ECE Standards for Unshelled Pistachio Nuts and Decorticated, and Decorticated Peeled Pistachio Nuts.

Item 9 Discussions on a multilingual Dictionary of Defects

AGRI/WP.1/GE.2/R.97 (already submitted to the Meeting of Experts in 1997) presents a multilingual dictionary prepared by the delegation of Italy. Delegates are requested to review this document and send their respective language version to the delegation of Italy.
