1. PROPOSAL

Annex 21,

Insert a new paragraph 2.2.1., to read:

A2.2.1. The light transmission of a glass pane, component type approved in accordance with the requirements set out in the Regulation and bearing the appropriate type approval mark, shall not be modified subsequently through the affixing of a plastic film.@

2. JUSTIFICATION

The addition of a plastic film, in an approved glass, is becoming customary in Spain.

It is considered by Spain that this practice invalidates the original glass approval. Therefore, it would be appropriate to indicate in the Regulation that after a glass pane approval, plastic film cannot be added.
