Matters for consideration or action by the Conference of the Parties: reporting

Reporting pursuant to Article 15 of the Convention**

Note by the Secretariat

- 1. Paragraph 1 of Article 15 of the Stockholm Convention requires each Party to report to the Conference of the Parties on the measures it has taken to implement the provisions of the Convention and on the effectiveness of such measures in meeting the objectives of the Convention. Paragraph 2 of that Article sets out the information to be reported, and paragraph 3 stipulates that reporting must be carried out at periodic intervals and in a format to be decided by the Conference of the Parties at its first meeting.
- 2. By its decision SC-1/22, the Conference of the Parties decided that, in accordance with Article 15 of the Convention, each Party should submit its first report by 31 December 2006, for consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its third meeting. By that decision, the Conference also adopted the format for reporting pursuant to Article 15 that is set out in the annex to the decision.
- 3. In its decision SC-2/18, the Conference of the Parties adopted the format for reporting on polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) contained in the annex to that decision and requested the Secretariat to develop an electronic system for reporting pursuant to Article 15 of the Convention and to make it available to Parties no later than 30 September 2006, in time for it to be used by Parties when preparing their first reports pursuant to Article 15.
- 4. In response to the above request the Secretariat developed an electronic system for reporting and made it available to Parties on the Convention's website (www.pops.int). Parties and others were invited to test the electronic system for reporting and to provide feed back to the Secretariat during an

initial trial period of one month, after which individual secured Party accounts were set up to allow each Party to manage its own data and to submit its national report directly to the Secretariat through the electronic system.

- 5. Each Party to the Convention has been assigned two individual accounts and passwords in order to access the electronic system for reporting. The first account is intended for the exclusive use of the official contact point and allows her or him to coordinate the data collection at the national level, certify the electronic submission and submit the report to the Secretariat officially. The second account is intended for the use of technical staff responsible for providing the different data required from each Party. This user is not permitted by the system to submit the report officially.
- 6. The Secretariat has provided the individual user names and passwords of the relevant accounts to those Parties that have nominated official contact points pursuant to decision SC-2/16 on official communications with Parties and observers. As of 7 February 2007, the Secretariat had distributed individual user identifications and passwords to 55 Parties.
- 7. Paragraph 2 (d) of Article 20 of the Stockholm Convention requires the Secretariat to prepare and make available to the Parties periodic reports based on information received pursuant to Article 15 and other available information.
- 8. At the time of preparing the present note, the Secretariat had received national reports from 23 Parties. Fifteen reports had been submitted through the official channels (i.e., via the official contact point designated pursuant to decision SC-2/16) and the remaining eight Parties had used alternative means and were invited to resubmit their reports through the official channels.
- 9. Reports submitted by the following Parties were accepted: Australia, Brazil, Burundi, Cambodia, Chile, Costa Rica, European Community, Germany, Lithuania, Mali, Norway, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden and Uruguay. National reports submitted to the Secretariat through the official contact points are available for viewing and downloading at the Convention website. A status list of the national reports received by the Secretariat pursuant to Article 15 is set out in the annex to the present note. A brief analysis of the reports received by the Secretariat is contained in table 1 below.
- 10. Pursuant to Annex A, Part II, subparagraph (g) of the Stockholm Convention, 10 of the 15 Parties whose reports where accepted included a part C on progress in eliminating polychlorinated biphenyls in addition to the mandatory parts A and B.
- 11. Four Parties out of the 55 Parties that were provided with individual user identifications and passwords reported difficulties when trying to use the electronic system for reporting.

Possible action by the Conference of the Parties

- 12. The Conference may wish:
 - (a) To take note of the information contained in the present note;
- (b) To encourage Parties that have not yet done so to submit their national reports pursuant to Article 15 of the Convention to the Secretariat no later than 31 July 2007;
- (c) To request the Secretariat to prepare a periodic report pursuant to paragraph 2 (d) of Article 20 of the Convention by 30 July 2008, in time to be used in the effectiveness evaluation under Article 16 of the Convention;
 - (d) To encourage Parties that have not used the electronic system for reporting to do so;
- (e) To invite Parties to provide comments on their experience using the electronic system for reporting to the Secretariat by 31 December 2007;
- (f) To request the Secretariat to develop a users manual for the electronic system and to distribute it widely in order to facilitate the process for reporting pursuant to Article 15 of the Convention;
- (g) To request the Secretariat, to provide training, upon request and subject to availability of funds, to enable Parties to use the electronic system for reporting effectively.
