Draft decision submitted by the President of the General Assembly

Dates for the meetings of the process of intergovernmental negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 68/6 of 9 October 2013, in particular paragraph 20, in which it decided to launch a process of intergovernmental negotiations at the beginning of the sixty-ninth session of the General Assembly, which would lead to the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda,

Recalling also its resolution XXX on the organization of the United Nations summit for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda, and cognizant of the decision on the modalities for the process of intergovernmental negotiations, which shall be taken by the end of December 2014,

1. *Decides* to convene meetings of the process of intergovernmental negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda, consistent with its resolution XXX (summit modalities), on the following dates:

19 to 21 January 2015 [3 days]

17 to 20 February 2015 [4 days]

23 to 27 March 2015 [5 days]

20 to 24 April 2015 [5 days]

18 to 22 May 2015 [5 days]

22 to 25 June 2015 [4 days]

20 to 24 July 2015 and 27 to 31 July 2015 [10 days]



2. *Invites* all Member States and other potential donors to consider contributing generously to all relevant United Nations trust funds in order to support the travel and participation of the representatives from developing countries, in particular the least developed countries, in the meetings of the process of the intergovernmental negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda;

3. *Underlines* the importance of ensuring the participation of the representatives of developing countries, in particular the least developed countries, in the process of intergovernmental negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda, and requests the Secretary-General to provide timely and regular updates on the availability of financial resources from the relevant trust funds for the consideration of Member States, with a view to providing all necessary support for the participation of developing countries, in particular least developed countries, in the meetings of this process;

4. *Stresses* the need for flexibility in convening meetings of the process of intergovernmental negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda, and notes in this regard the possibility of convening additional meetings, if necessary, of up to 5 days duration, including for synergies with other relevant processes, while ensuring the efficient use of resources.
