## Message addressed to the Heads of State or Government of non-aligned countries

The extremely serious developments occurring in Angola constitute a direct threat to peace and security in Africa and throughout the world. The situation there is now characterized by the open military intervention of the racist régime of South Africa and the massive use of mercenaries by forces allied to imperialism, with the clear aim of infringing the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the new People's Republic of Angola, as proclaimed on 11 November 1975. The naked collusion between South Africa, the imperialist forces and the reo-colonialists in Angola has clearly revealed a scheme to replace Portuguese colonialism in Angola by new forms of domination and exploitation, thus aggravating a situation in that part of Africa which was already explosive owing to the existence of racist The non-aligned countries, whose basic objectives have always been the real and authentic liberation of peoples and the success of the struggle against imperialism and neo-colonialism, cannot turn a blind eye to developments of this I am certain that the non-aligned countries, taking note of the solemn declaration in which the Government of the People's Republic of Angola affirmed its total support for and devotion to the principle of the policy of non-alignment, will not fail to give the situation their fullest attention, to denounce and condemn the aggression to which their brothers, the Angolan people, have been subjected and to express their full solidarity with the people and leaders of Angola. That posture, which is consistent with the ideals of our Movement, is in keeping with our long tradition of support for just causes.
