Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 55th meeting, on 11 December 1980, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/104) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution I recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 27 of its report (A/35/665/Add.1) as well as the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/35/7/Add.26).
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (see A/C.5/35/SR.55).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution I recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 27 of its report (A/35/665/Add.1), an additional appropriation of \$17,500 would be required under section 2B of the programme budget for 1980-1981.
