DECLARATION

OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE BULGARIAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCES

AT THE 26TH CONGRESS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTYOF THE SOVIET UNION LEONID ILICH BREZHNEV PROPOSED THE SETTING UP OF AN AUTHORITATIVE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE, COMPOSED OF MOST EMINENT SCIENTISTS FROM ALL COUNTRIES IN THE WORLD, WHICH WOULD POINT TO THE VITAL NECESSITY OF PREVENTING A NUCLEAR HOLOCAUST. THE BULGARIAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCES OFFERS ITS UNRESERVED SUPPORT TO THIS PROPOSAL. THE SETTING UP OF SUCH AN INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE WILL HELP THE NATIONS REALIZE MORE CLEARLY THE DISASTROUS CONSEQUENCES FOR MANKIND OF A NUCLEAR WAR. THIS IS OF VITAL IMPORTANCE PARTICULARLY NOW WHEN THERE IS A SERIOUS THREAT TO PEACE. THE GOVERNMENTS OF SOME OF THE BIG STATES DISREGARD THE FATE OF MANKIND. THE MILITARY BUDGETS IN THESE COUNTRIES INCREASE AT AN ALARMING RATE, THE ARMS RACE LEADS STEADILY STEP BY STEP THROUGH RECKLESS ESCALATION TO NUCLEAR CATASTROPHE.

THE SAFEGUARDING OF PEACE UNDER THE EXISTING CONDITIONS IN THE WORLD REQUIRES ACTIVE, CONSISTENT AND TOTAL STRUGGLE FOR PEACE. THE SETTING UP OF AN INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE OF SCIENTISTS, AS PROPOSED BY L. I. BREZHNEV, CAN SIGNIFICANTLY ASSIST IN THIS STRUGGLE. TO PREJUDICE, FRAUD, FEAR AND HATRED IT WILL OPPOSE THE PRESTIGE OF SCIENCE AND AUTHORITATIVE SCIENTIFIC CONCLUSIONS SO AS TO AROUSE PUBLIC OPINION IN THE WORLD. IN THIS WAY THE PEOPLES WILL BE ABLE TO UNDERSTAND BETTER THAT A NUCLEAR WAR THREATENS

- -- NOT ISOLATED GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS BUT THE WHOLE PLANET;
- NOT PARTICULAR PEOPLES BUT MANKIND;
- NOT PARTICULAR CULTURAL VALUES BUT HUMAN CIVILIZATION.

IT IS IMPERATIVE TO KEEP PEOPLE INFORMED ABOUT THE DANGEROUS MOVES OF THE MILITARISTS, ABOUT EXCESSIVE ARMAMENT, ABOUT THE DESTRUCTIVE FORCE OF THE STOCK-PILED NUCLEAR WEAPONS DIRECTED AGAINST LIVING HUMAN BEINGS. IT IS IMPERATIVE TO UNMASK THE VICIOUS INSINUATIONS THAT NUCLEAR WAR IS NOT SO DANGEROUS AND THAT A "LIMITED" NUCLEAR WAR WHICH WOULD NOT THREATEN ALL MANKIND IS POSSIBLE. IT SHOULD BE IMPRESSED ON THE NATIONS WITH SUFFICIENT AUTHORITY THAT, WITH THE EXISTING ALIGNMENT OF FORCES IN THE WORLD, A "LIMITED" NUCLEAR WAR IS IMPOSSIBLE. IN A FUTURE WAR EACH NUCLEAR EXPLOSION WOULD INEVITABLY LEAD TO WORLD

NUCLEAR EXPLOSION. THE NATIONS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT A NUCLEAR WAR WOULD OBLITERATE EUROPE FROM THE FACE OF THE EARTH AND WOULD MEAN THOUSANDS OF HIROSHIMAS IN THE PLACES OF THE FLOURISHING TOWNS ON OUR CONTINENT.

THEREFORE, THE FORCES STAKING ON NUCLEAR WAR SHOULD MEET THE RESISTANCE AND POWER OF SCIENCE, SUPPORTED BY THE AUTHORITATIVE CONCLUSIONS OF THE PROGRESSIVE SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY IN THE WORLD. THE DANGEROUS DOCTRINE THAT PEACE IS POSSIBLE ONLY WHEN SUPPORTED BY ARMAMENT SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO TRIUMPH. SCIENTISTS BEAR RESPONSIBILITY TO THEIR OWN CONSCIENCE, TO THE NATIONS AND TO HISTORY FOR THE SAFEGUARDING OF PEACE. BEING INVOLVED IN SCIENCE, THEY ARE BEST AWARE OF THE DISASTERS WHICH A NUCLEAR WAR WOULD BRING TO MANKIND. THEREFORE THEY SHOULD STRUGGLE AGAINST THE ASPIRATIONS OF THE WARMONGERS TO USE THE GREAT DISCOVERIES OF OUR CENTURY, ATTAINED AS A RESULT OF SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL PROGRESS, FOR DESTRUCTIVE PURPOSES. SCIENCE SHOULD SERVE THE WELFARE OF MANKIND, THE FLOURISHING OF CIVILIZATION AND THE TRIUMPH OF PEACE.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE BULGARIAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCES APPEALS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ORGANIZATION AND TO ALL ACADEMIES OF SCIENCES IN EUROPE TO SET UP AN INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE OF DISTINGUISHED AND AUTHORITATIVE SCIENTISTS WITH THE PURPOSE OF DEFENDING MANKIND FROM THE THREAT OF A NUCLEAR CATASTROPHE.
