THAI VIOLATIONS OF KAMPUCHEAN SOVEREIGNTY DENOUNCED.

HANOI VNA APRIL 19 -- The Kampuchean News Agency SPK today denounced Thailand for conducting reconnaissance flights into Kampuchean airspace and 149 artillery shellings of Kampuchean territory within last week.

Thailand's L-19 aircraft reconnoitred the Odar, Konrieng, Poipet and Preah Vihear areas situated from three to five kilometres inside Kampuchean territory.

From April 8-11, Thai troops fired 105-mm artillery and 120-mm mortar rounds into the area west of Nimit in Battambang province.

On April 12, Thai troops conducted 17 artillery and mortar shellings of the area West of Smatdong, from five to eight kilometres behind the border line. Earlier, on April 9 and 10, Thailand's 82-mm and 120-mm mortar shells were fired at Kampuchea's Hills 322 and 326.

On April 7, Thai frontier guards in Khlonyai fired 105-mm artillery and 82-mm recoilless - gun shells at Kampuchea's Hill 107.

On the other hand, Thai vessels intruded into Kampuchea's waters near Kohtang island on 186 occasions in the same week.

THAI ARMED PROVOCATIONS AGAINST KAMPUCHEA

HANOI VNA APRIL 28 -- From April 16 to 20, Thailand conducted ten reconnaissance flights over Kampuchea, SPK reports.

The planes circle over the provincial town of Koh Kong and an area West of Konrient located at ten kilometres from the frontier.

On the sea, Thai armed vessels made 134 incursions into Kampuchean waters.

Meanwhile, Thai artillery made eight bombardments against the Preah Vihear region causing one dead and two wounded among the civilian population.

Sixteen artillery shellings were recorded in Siem Reap - Battambang region, and in the Pursat - Koh Kong region, hundreds of shells were fired on the areas West of Smatdeng and in the vicinity of Hills 336 and 172.
