Letter dated 15 September 1982 from the Permanent Representative of
Viet Nam to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to draw your attention to the letter dated 7 September 1982 addressed to you by the Permanent Representative of Thailand to the United Nations (A/37/429-S/15388) and to inform you that the so-called incidents mentioned in that letter are nothing but slanderous and tendentious fabrications.

The Socialist Republic of Viet Nam consistently follows a policy of good-neighbourliness with Thailand, consisting of respect for the sovereignty, security and territorial integrity of Thailand.

We find it regrettable that such fabrications on the part of Thailand inevitably damage the atmosphere of dialogue which has recently developed between the two countries, with the aim of safeguarding and promoting peace, stability and co-operation in South-East Asia.

I should be grateful if you would arrange for the text of this letter to be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly, under items 20 and 35 of the provisional agenda, and of the Security Council.
