## Letter dated 15 Apr 111985 from the Permanent Representative of Atghanistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that the Charge diatfaires of the Pakistan Fmbasay in Kabul was aummoned to the Ministry of Foreian Affaira of the Democratic Republic ot Afqhanistan at 3.30 p.m. on 13 April 1985 and the following was pointed out to him by the Director of the first Political Department:
"According to the information received from the pertinent authoritien of the Democratic Republic ot Atqhaniatan, in apite of the repeated pronouncementa of the Democratic Repuhlic of Afghaniatan, the armed and

Irresponaible aqqeasiona of the pakistani frontier torces aqainat realdential districts are continuing with the use of heavy weapons auch af mortars and recoilleas quna.
"In the course ot 25 days, namely, from 15 March to 9 April 1985 , realdential areas ot Barikot Diatrict, Kunar Province, came under heavy fire l.3 timea on $15,19,20,21,22,23,24,27$ and 31 March and 4, 6, 8,9 April. Among others, on 8 and 9 April, the dwellings of the populacion were hrought under intensive tire, as a result of which some children and women were martyred and several reaidential housen were destroyed as alan areat loasen were inflicted to the crops of the people.
"The authoritiea of the Democratic Republic of Afquanistan aerinusly condemn theme agareasions of the pakistani frontior forces and the arming and diapatching of handits into the terittory of the Democratic Repuhife of Atahaniatan for murder and plunder and atronaly protest over them to the Government of pakiatan. It is to be mentioned further that the pakimeani authorities must put an immediate and to these armed aqaremaions and interterence which have caused enormous human and material losaes and have posed a danqer to the eecurity of the trontier areas. Otherwise, the reaponeibility for their dangeroun and heavy consequencea shall reat with the militariat athorities of Pakiatan."

Likewise, the Director of the First Political Department atated to the Pakiatan Charge d'atiadrea that:
"The Pakiatani authoritima, in order to cover up their aqgreasive actions, in continuation of their baseless previous accuastiona aqainat the Democratic Republic of Atghaniatan, have once aqain claimed that four Atqhan aircraft have alleqedly penetrated 4 kilometres into the airspace of Chitral on 11 April 1985 and have dropped 9 homba on an area 3 kilometram mouth-east of Arando which have caused no dainaqe.
"The concerned authoritiea of the Democratic kepuhlic of Atghaniatan consider this claim as a qroundlesa and malicious alleqation and cateaorically reject it. They demand the Government of pakiatan to put an end to auch inginuations which hava no other reault but increased tanaion in the frontier."

I have further the honour to requeat Your Fxcellency to arranap for the circulation of this letter as a document of the General Agsembly, under itemg 72, 73, 132, 133 and 138 ot the preliminary liat, and of the security council.
