Page 50, paragraph 127

61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 68, 69, 70, 71, 75, 80, 82, 86, 91, 92, 96, 107, and 108 of the provisional agenda*

127. The Ministers welcomed with satisfaction the attitude of the Korean people in their efforts to reunify their homeland peacefully and to achieve this goal free of all foreign interference, by means of dialogue and consultation between North and South, in conformity with the three principles of independence, peaceful reunification and great national unity set forth in the joint North-South statement of 4 July 1972.
