Further to my letter dated 8 October 1986 (A/41/693-S/18388), I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Pakistan has rejected as baseless the allegatian made by the Kabul authorities that, on 9 October 1986, an aircraft of the Pakistan Air Force violated Afghan airspace in the area of Band-e-Kamal Khan of Nimroz Province. Pakistan's rejection of the allegation was conveyed to the Afghan Chargé d'affaires on 13 October 1986.
