Letter dated 23 June 1987 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government. i have the honour to br inq to your attention yet another instance of the utter disregard of Iraqi rulers for the norms of international law governing the conduct of hostilities. On Monday, 21 June 1987, the Ir. I forces twice resorted to chemical warfare in the Nasr-4 operational theatre. Chemical agents, consisting of suffocating and nerve gases, were del ivered through at tiller; barrages and rockets dropped by helicopters in Espidarre Valley, Kulan Heights, the elopes of Qashan and Kulan Heights and the outskirts of Mawut township. Several Iranian combatants were injured as a result of the aggressor Iraqi régime's deployment of illegal chemical weapons.

It would be highly appreciated if **this** letter were **circul**; ted as a document of the General Assembly, under **item** 62 of **the** preliminary 1 ist, **and** of the Security Council,
