Letter dated 29 June 1987 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that the Iraqi **régime,** in continuation of its acts of lawlessness, once again resorted to chemical warfare in the north-western region on 26 June 1987. Chemical rockets fired from helicopters **w.re** used to deliver suffocating and nerve gases, which resulted in injury to **more** than 60 people.

It **would** be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under item 62 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
