Letter dated 13 July 1987 from the Permanent Representative of
the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed
to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour and the sad duty to inform you that in continuation of the abominable Iraqi chemical bombardments of Iranian territory, on 29 June 1987, at 2000 hours (local time), two Iraqi helicopters dropped chemical bombs in the area of Sardasht, wounding two people. Also, on 1 July 1987, at 2215 hours (local time), the enemy fired two artillery chemical shells containing nerve gas at the Baneh area, injuring 10 people, while on 11 July 1987, at 900 hours (local time), Iraqi war-planes chemically bombarded the Piranshahr-Sardasht road.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under item 62 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council,
