## Letter dated 15 July 1987 from the Permanent Representative of Iraq to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to attach a copy of the article entitled "Namibia uranium may fuel Iran's A-bomb" which appeared in the Sunday, 17 May 1987, edition of the Br i tish weekly The Observer, According to the article, the Iranian régime is continuing to buy uranium from the Rossing mine, in which the Iranian Government has a 10 per cent shareholding, situated in Namibian territory occupied by the South African racist régime.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter and its annex circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under items 33, 36, 47 and 51 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
