Letter dated 16 July 1987 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour and the very sad duty to inform you that one of the civilian victims of the criminal Iraqi chemical attack on Sardasht on 28 June 1987 died at a military hospital in Madrid because of the severity of his respiratory injuries. The victim, Qader Karim-Vahed, was one of eight victims of the chemical hombardment under treatment at the hospital in Madrid. The eight include Mr. Karim-Vahed's wife, who is also severely injured, as well as a mother and her two small children.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under item 62 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
