GENERAL AND COMPLETE DISARMAMENT

Prohibition of the development, production, stockpiling and use of radiological weapons

Report of the Secretary-Genera;

1. On 3 December 1986, the General Assembly adopted resolution 41/59 1, the operative part of which reads as follows:

"The General Assembly,

"...

- "1. Reaffirms that military attacks of any kind against nuclear facilities are tantamount to the use of radiological weapons, due to the dangerous radioactive forces that such attacks cause to be released;
- "i!, Requests the Conference on Disarmament to reach, as early as possible, an agreement prohibiting military attacks against nuclear facilities;
- "A Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-second session on the progress made in the implementation of the present resolution."
- 2. Pursuant to paragraphs 2 and 3 of the resolution, the Secretary-General refers the members of the General Assembly to paragraphs 86 to 88 of the report of the Conference on Disarmament submitted to the Assembly at its forty-second session (A/42/27).
