IMPLEMENTATION OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION **41/54** ON THE IMMEDIATE CESSATION AND PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR-WEAPON TESTS

Report of the First Committee

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The item entitled "Implementation of General Assembly resolution 41/54 on the immediate cessation and prohibition of nuclear-weapon tests: report of the Conference on Disarmament" was included in the **provisional** agenda of the forty-second session in accordance with General Assembly resolution 41/54 of 3 December 1986.
- 2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 18 **September** 1987, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Conittee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the First Committee.
- 3. At its 2nd meeting, on 1 October, the First **Committee** decided to hold a general debate **on** the disarmament items allocated to it, namely, items 48 to 69, followed by statements on specific disarmament agenda items and a continuation of the general debate, as **necessary**. The deliberations on those items took place between the 3rd and the 31st meetings, from 12 October to 3 November (See A/C.1/42/PV.3-31).
