ISRAELI NUCLEAR ARMAMENT

Report of the First Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Kazimierz TOMASZEWSkI (Poland)

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The item entitled "Israeli nuclear rrmamentr report of the Secretary-General" was included in the provisional agenda of the forty-second session in accordance with General Assembly resolut ion 41/93 of 4 December 1986.

2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 18 September 1987, the General Assembly, on the recommendat ion of the General Committee, decided to include the i tern in its agenda and to allocate it t o the First Committee.

3. At its 2nd meeting, on 1 October, the First Committee decided to hold a general debate on the disarmament items allocated to it, namely, items 48 to 69, followed by statements on specific disarmament agenda items and a cortinuation of the general debate, as necessary. The deliberations on those items took place between the 3rd and the 31st meetings, from 12 October to 3 November (see A/C.1/42/PV.3-31).

4. In connection with item 68, the First Committee had before it the iollowing documents:

(d) Letter dated 23 October 1987 from the Permanent Representative of Zimbabwe to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General, transmitting the final communique of the Meeting of Ministers for Foreign Affairs and Heads of Delegation of the Movement of Non-Aligned Countries to the forty-second session of the General Assembly, held in New York from 5 to 7 October 1987 (A/42/681).

II. CONSIDERATIOU OF DRAFT RESOLUTION A/C. 1/42/L. 15

5. On 23 October, Algeria, Bahrain, Democratic Yemen, Djibouti, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Mauritania, Morocco, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, the Sudan, the Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates and Yemen submitted a draft resolution, entitled "Israeli nuclear armament" (A/C.1/42/L.15), which was introduced by the representative of Iraq at the 27th meeting, on 30 October.

III. RECOMMENDATION ON THE FIRST COMMITTEE

7. The First **Committee** recommends to the **General** Asaembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Israeli nuclear armament

The General Assembly,

Beal ing in mind its previous resolut ions on Israeli nuclear armament, the latest of which is 41/93 of 4 December 1986,

<u>Recalling</u> resolution 41/48 of 3 December 1986, in which, <u>inter alia</u>, it called or placing all nuclear facilities in the region under International Atomic Energy Agency safeguards, rending the establishment of a nuclear-weapon-free zone in the Middle Eaet,

<u>Recalling further</u> Security Council resolution 487 (1981) of 19 June 1981 in which, inter <u>alia</u>, the Council called upon Israel urgently to place all its nuclear facilities under International Atomic Energy Agency safeguards,

<u>Noting</u> that Only Israel has been specifically called upon by the Security Council to place its nuclear facilities under Internat ional Atomic Energy Agency saf equards,

<u>Taking note</u> with appreciation of the report of the Secretary-General on Israeli nuclear armament, 2/

<u>Noting with grive concern</u> Israel's persistent refusal to commit itself not to manufacture or acquire nuclear weapons, despite repeated calls by the General Assembly, the Security Council and the International Atomic Energy Agency,

<u>Taking into consideration</u> resolution GC(XXXI)/RES/470 adopted by the General Conference of the International Atomic Energy Agency, in which it called upon Israel to place all its nuclear facilities Under International Atomic Energy Agency saf guards,

<u>Deeply alarmed</u> by recent information in regard to the cont inuing production, development and acquisition of nuclear weapons by Israel,

<u>Aware</u> of the grave consequences that endanger international peace and security as a result of Israel's development and acquisition of nuclear weapons and Israel's collaboration with South Africa to develop nuclear weapons and their delivery systems,

<u>Deeply concerned</u> that the declared Israeli policy of attacking and destroying nuclear facilities devoted to peaceful purpose:, is a part of its nuclear armament policy, .

1. <u>Reiterates its condemnation</u> of Israel's refusal to renounce any possession of nuclear weapons;

2. <u>Reiterates also its condemnat ion</u> of the co-operation between Israel and South Africa;

3. <u>Requests once more the Security Council to take urgent and affective</u> measures to ensure that Israel complies with Security Council resolution 487 (1981);

4. <u>Calls upon all States and organizations that have not yet done so to</u> discontinue do-operating with and giving assistance to Israel in the nuclear field;

5. <u>Reiterates its request</u> to the International Atomic Energy Agency to suepend any scientific co-operation with Ierael which could contribute to its nuclear capabilities;

6. <u>Requests also</u> the internat ional Atomic Energy Agency to inform the Secretary-General of any stops Israel may undertake to place its nuclear facilities under International Atomic Energy Agency safeguards;

7. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to follow closely Israeli nuclear activities and to report to the General Assembly at its forty-third session!

8. <u>Decides</u> to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-third session the item entitled "Israeli nuclear armament".
