Letter dated 2% March 1988 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i., of the **Permanent** Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instruction9 from my Government and pursuant to my previous letters concerning the unprecedented use of **chemical** weapons by the Iraqi **régime**, **T** have the honour to draw Your Excellency's attention to General Assembly resolution 42/37 C entitled "Measures to uphold the authority of the 1925 Geneva Protocol and to support the conclusion of a chemical weapons convention". In paragraph 4 of that resolution, the General Assembly:

"<u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to carry out investigations in response to reports that may be brought to his attention by any Member State concerning the possible use of chemical and hacteriological (biological) or toxin weapons that. may constitute a violation of the 1925 Geneva Protocol or other relevant rules of customary international, law in order to ascertain the facts of the matter, and to report, promptly the results of ny such investigation to all Member Staten."

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran has brought to Your Excellency's attention a very serious escalation in the use of chemical weapons by 'Iraq, primarily against civilian populations. It has officially requested the immediate "dispatch of the United Nations team of Experts on Chemical Weapons to the region to investigate the extent of Iraqi crime and to report to the international **community**". It is imperative that immediate action by you, in line with the provisions of General Assembly resolution 42/37 C, be adopted in order to "uphold the authority of the 1925 Geneva Protocol".
