Prohibition of the development, production, stockpi) ng and use of radiological weapons

Report of the Secretary-General

1. On 30 November 1987, the General Assembly adopted resolution 42/38 F, the operative pert of which reads as follows:

"The General Assembly,

"...

- "1. Reaffirms that armed attacks of any kind against nuclear facilities are tentamount to the use of radiological weapons, owing to the dangerour radioactive forces that such attacks cause to be released;
- "2, Requests the Conference on Disarmament to intensify further its ef forts to reach, as early as possible, an agreement prohibiting armed attacks against nuclear facilities;
- "3. Requesta the International Atomic Energy Agency to provide thr Conference on Disarmament with the technical studies that would facilitate the conclusion of such an agreement;
- "4. Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-third session on the progress made in the implementation of the present resolution."
- 2. Pursuant to paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of the resolution, the Secretary-General draws the attention of Member States to paragraphs 84 to 86 of the report of the Conference on Disarmament submitted to the Assembly as its forty-third session. 1/
