#### Report of the First Committee

#### T. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The item entitled \*'Implementation of the conclusions of the Third Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and Establishment of a Preparatory Committee for the Fourth Review Conference" was included as a supplementary item in the agenda of the forty-third session in accordance with a letter dated 12 August 1988 from the representative of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-Qeneral (A/43/191 and Rev. 1).
- 2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1988, the Qeneral Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the First Committee.
- 3. At its 2nd meeting, on 12 October 1988, the First Committee decided to hold a general debate on the disarmament items allocated to it, namely, items 51 to 69, 139, 141 and 145, The deliberation8 on those items took place at the 3rd to 25th meetings, from 17 October to 2 November (see A/C.1/43/PV.3-25). Consideration of and action on draft resolutions on those items took place between 3 and 18 November (see A/C.1/43/PV.26-43).
- 4. In connection with item 141, the **First** Committoo had before **it** the letter **referred** to in paragraph 1, as well **as** a **letter** dated 21 October 1988 from **the** Permanent **Representative** of **the German** Democratic Republic to **the United** Nations addressed to **the** Secretary-General (A/43/741).

#### II. CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT RESOLUTION A/C.1/43/L.45

- On 31 October, Australia, Austria, Bangladesh, Belgium, Bolivia, Bulgaria, 5. Cameroon, Canada, Cyprus, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, the German Demogratic Republic, Germany, Federal Republic of, Greece, Guinea, Hungary, Iraq, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Kenya, Liberia, Luxembourg, Mexico, Mongolia, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Peru, the Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Samoa, Spain, Sweden, Thailand, Togo, Turkey, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the United States of America, Uruquay and Venezuela rubmitted a draft rolution entitled "Implementation of the conclusions of the Third Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and ● rtabli8hment of a preparatory committee for the Fourth Review Conference" (A/C.1/43/L.45), which war later also sponsored by Afghanistan, Colombia, Demogratic Yemen, Equador, Ghana, Iceland, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, Morocco, Sri Lanka, the Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia and Yemen. The draft revolution war introduced by the representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, at the 28th mooting, on 7 November.
- 6. In this connection, at the 38th mooting, on 15 November, the Secretary of the Committee stated that there were no programme budget implications of the draft revolution (see A/C.1/43/PV.38).
- 7. At the same meeting, the Committoo adopted the draft revolution by a recorded vote of 119 to none, with 9 abstentions (see para. 8). The voting was as follows:

### The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 2373 (XXII) of 12 June 1966, the annex to which contains the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons,

Noting the provisions of article VIII, paragraph 3, of that Treaty concerning the holding of successive review conferences,

Noting that, in the Final Document of the Third Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, held at Geneva from 27 August to 21 September 1985, the Conference proposed to the Depositary Governments that a fourth conference to review the operation of the Treaty be convened in 1990 and also noting that there appears to be a consensus among the parties that the Fourth Review Conference should be held at Coneva in August/September of that year,

- 1. Notes that, following appropriate consultations, an open-ended preparatory committee has been formed of parties to the Treaty on the Non-Prolimation of Nuclear Weapons serving on the Board of Governor8 of the Internation II. I Atomic Energy Agency or represented on the Conference on Disarmament well as any party to the Treaty that may express its interest in participation in the work of the preparatory committee;
- 2. Requests the Secretary-General to render the necessary assistance and to provide such services, including summary records, as may be required for the Fourth Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and its preparation,
