Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 21 November 1988 (A/43/849-5/20283), I have the honour to inform you that recently the Afghan WAD (Intelligence) Organization in Khost provided the following sabotage material to an agent for carrying out explosions in Afghan refugee camps in Kurram Agency:

- (a) TNT slabs - 2
- (b) Detonators - 2
- (c) Detonating cord .. 12 ft.

The Afghan **Chargé d'affaires** was **called** to the Foreign Office at **Islamabad** in the morning **of 29 November 1988**, and a strong protest was lodged with him over this action of the Afghan **régime**, which constitutes a **violation** of the **Geneva Accords**. **He was asked to inform** his authorities that if **such** activities **did not cease** the entire responsibility **for** the serious **consequences** would rest with the Kabul authorities,

I request to **have** this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, **under** agenda items **30, 72, 129, 133 and 136**, end **of** the **Security Council**.
