ANNEX

Declaration of the formation of the provisional Government of the State of Palestine, 15 November 1988

The Palestine National Council, at its nineteenth extraordinary session, the session of the intifadah, decides as followsr

- 1. A provisional Gove ament shall be formed for the State of Palestina as soon as possible, in accordance with circumstances and the evolution of events,
- 2. The Central Council and the Executive Committee of the Palortine Liberation Organisation shall be empowered to appoint a time for the formation of the provisional Qovernment, the Executive Committee shall be entrusted with its formation, and it shall be presented to the Central Council for a motion of confidence. The Central Council shall adopt the provisional system of government until such time as the Palestinian people exercises full governighty over the land of Palestine.
- 3. The provisional Government rhall be composed of Palestinian leaders, notables and skilled human resources within the occupied homeland and outside, on the basis of political pluralism and in such a manner as to embody national unity.
- 4. The provinicaal Government shall draw up its programma on the basis of the instrument of inderendence, the political programme of the Palestine Liberation Organisation and the resolutions of the national councils.
- 5. The Palertine National Council hereby entrusts the Executive Committee of the Palertine Liberation Organisation with the powers and responsibilities of the provisional Qovernment until such time as the formation of the Qovernment is declared,

Adopted by the National Council at **its** extraordinary session at Algiers on 15 November 1988,
