ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE FORTY-FOURTH REGULAR SESSION σ THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Fourth report of the General Committee

- 1. At its 4th meeting, on 11 October 1989, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Afghanistan, Algeria, Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, the Bahamas, Bangladesh, Barbados, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Cyprus, Djibouti, Dominica, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Ethiopia, the Gambia, Ghana, Grenada, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, India, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Jamaica, Jordan, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Malaysia, Mauritania, Mexico, Morocco, Nepal, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Sao Tome and Principa, Senegal, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Uruguay, Vanuatu, Venezuela, Yugoslavia and Zambia (2.44/244 and Add.1 and 2) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item, entitled;
- "Special session of the General Assembly to consider the question of international co-operation against illicit production, supply, demand, trafficking and distribution of narcotic drugs, with a view to expanding the scope and increasing the effectiveness of such co-operation".
- 2. In that connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:
 - (a) Should be included in the agenda;
 - (b) Should be considered directly in plenary meeting,
