# Press release issued by the President of ne Preparatory Meeting of the XVth Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meeting (9-13 May 1989)

The Proparatory Mooting of the XVth Antarctic Treaty Conrultativo Meeting was held in Paris from 9 to 13 May 1989.

The participant8 at this mooting were the 22 consultative Parties and 16 of thr 17 other States that are members of the Antarctic Treaty.

The main purpose of meeting was the preparation of the draft Agenda of the xvth Consultative Moating to be held in Paris from 9 to 19 October 1989 and to decide on invitations to international organizations to attend the xvth Antarctic Treaty Conrultativo Meeting.

Mattrrr relating to the protection of the Antarctic environment were the focus of attention of the meeting. Among others, items for the next agenda were included on:

Human impact on the Antarctic environment, including waste disposal;

Effects o f tourism;

Protected areas;

Marine pollution and maritime safety;

The role of Antarctica in global change, including the ozone layer.

Particular • mphasia was placed on an **item** setting forth an initiative to integrate new measures with existing ones to complete a comprehensive framework for the protection of the Antarctic environment.

Delegations took advantage of their attendance at the Meeting to receive a report on the actions taken to respond to a recent accident to a vessel in Antarctica (Bahia de Paraiso).

The report described the extensive co-operation among Parties to the Treaty to deal with the accident and mitigate its affect on the environment, including monitoring of any long-term impacts.

They also acknowledged the *need* to loarn the lessons from this experience in building upon existing measures to protect the environment.

It was **recognized** that the initiative to be launched at the **XVth** Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meeting **wow.ld** provide the necessary basis for reaching those objectives.
