REPORT OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ISRAELI PRACTICES AFFECTING THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF THE POPULATION OF THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

Report of the Secretary-General

(in pursuance of General Assembly resolution 43/58 C)

1. The present report is submitted in pursuance of General Assembly resolution 43/58 C of 6 December 1988, the operative part of which reads as followsr

"The General Assembly,

. . . .

- "1. <u>Determines</u> that all such measures and actions taken by Israel *in* the Palestinian and other Arab territories occupied since 1967, including Jerusalem, are in violation of the relevant provisions of the Geneva Convention relative to the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War, of 12 August 1949, and constitute a serious obstacle to the efforts to achieve a comprehensive, just and lasting peace in the Middle East and therefore have no legal validity;
- "2. <u>Strongly deplores</u> the persistence of Israel in carrying out such measures, in particular the establishment of settlements in the Palestinian and other occupied Arab Territories, including Jerusalem;
- "3. <u>Demands</u> that Israel comply strictly with its international obligations in accordance with the principles of international law and the provisions of the Geneva Convention1
- "4. Demands once more that Israel, the occupying Power, desist forthwith from taking any action which would result in changing the legal status,

geographical naturs or demographic composition of the Palestinian and other Arab territories occupied since 1967, including Jerusalemi

- "5. <u>Urgently calls upon</u> all States parties to the Geneva Convention to respect and to exert all <u>efforts in</u> order to ensure respect for and compliance with its provisions in all Palestinian and other Arab territories occupied by *Israel* since 1967, including Jerusalem;
- **"6.** Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-fourth session on the implementation of the present resolution."
- 2. On 30 May 1989, the Secretary-General addressed a note **verbale** to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Israel, in which he requested, in view of his reporting responsibilities under the resolution, that the **Minister** for Foreign Affairs inform him of any **steps** his Government had taken or envisaged taking in implementation of the relevant provisions of the resolution.
- 3. By a note **verbale** dated 18 August 1989, the Acting Permanent Representative of Israel to the United Nations replied with regard to General Assembly resolution 43/58 C as follows:

"The position of Israel was set out fully in the statement made by Israel's representative in the Special Political Committee on 13 November 1986 (A/SPC/41/SR.27) and on 19 November 1987 (A/SPC/42/SR.30)."
