REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Human rights in southern Lebanon**Note by the Secretary-General**

1. By its **decision 1989/157** of 24 May 1989, the Economic and Social Council took note **of** the **report** of the Commission on Human Rights, **1/** containing resolution **1989/65** of **8** March 1989 on the situation of human rights in southern **Lebanon**. In paragraph 4 **of** the resolution, the Commission requested the Secretary-General (a) **to** bring the resolution to the attention **of** the Government of Israel and to invite that Government to provide information concerning the extent **of** its implementation thereof and (b) to report to the General Assembly at its forty-fourth session and to the **Commission on Human Rights** at its forty-sixth session on **the** results of his efforts in that regard.

2. In accordance with the request, the Secretary-General, on 14 April 1989, addressed a note **verbale** to the Minister for Foreign Affairs **of** Israel, in which he drew the attention **of** the Minister for Foreign Affairs to paragraph 4 of the above-mentioned resolution.

3. No reply had been received at the time **of** the preparation of the present report.
