- 1. I have the honour to refer to resolution 42/38 C, adopted by the General Assembly on 30 November 1987, entitled "Notification of nuclear tests", paragraph 3 of which requests States that, while not themselves conducting nuclear explosions, possess data on such events to make such data available to the Secretary-General.
- 2. In accordance with that request, I have the honour to attach, in an appendix. details of nuclear-test explosions carried out by France in the South Pacific in the course of 1989. The testing took place at Mururoa and Fangataufa Atolls. Estimates of the yield of each explosion are based on hydroacoustic signals recorded by the New Zealand Seismic Observatory at Rarotonga.
