- 1. At its 3Yth meeting, on 30 November 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/49) on the programme budyot implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/45/776). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were prosanted orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/45/SR.39).
- 3. A statement in explanation of position was made by the representative of Japan.

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 4. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/45/776).
- (a) An additional appropriation of \$28,800 would be required under section **2B** (Disarmament affairs activities) of the programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991;

(b) Such requirements would constitute an additional expenditure derived from legislative mandates notprovided for in the programme budget for 1990-1991 and would therefore be subject to the quidelines for the use of the contingency fund approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987,
