ANNEX

Statement of the Government of the Republic of Albania  
on the recognition of the independence of the Republic  
of Bosnia-Herzegovina

The Government of the Republic of Albania, respecting the right of the peoples for self-determination, based on the fundamental principles embodied in the Final Act of Helsinki, in the Charter of Paris, in the other documents of CSCE, as well as in the implementation of its good neighbourliness policy, declares that it recognizes the independence of the Republic of Bosnia-Herzegovina.

The further approach in the establishment of diplomatic relations with this sovereign and independent State will be according to the bilateral relations basis.

The Albanian people and Government, hailing this significant event for the people of Bosnia-Herzegovina, at the same time express their conviction that the creation of this new and independent State will contribute in the solution of Yugoslav crisis, it will serve the relaxation of the situation and other confrontations in the former Yugoslavia will not be incited. They are also confident that the new and independent State of Bosnia-Herzegovina will make a contribution to the maintenance of peace and stability in the Balkans.

On this occasion, the Government of the Republic of Albania wishes to remind the whole democratic world, especially Europe and the United States of America, to powerfully contribute in the solution of the just demands of the Albanians living in their own territories in former Yugoslavia, to make them equal among the European Community, thus putting an end forever to the injustices committed at their expense.
