ANNEX

Statement by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the
Republic of Kazakhstan of 24 May 1995

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has been authorized to state that the Republic of Kazakhstan, strictly complying with its obligations under the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and the Treaty on the Reduction and Limitation of Strategic Offensive Arms, has removed from its territory all nuclear weapons.

The security guarantees provided to Kazakhstan by the nuclear Powers - the United States of America, the Russian Federation, China, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and France - played an important role enabling our State to carry out its obligations under the Treaties in question.

Steadfastly advocating the strengthening of the nuclear non-proliferation regime, Kazakhstan, at the recent Conference on the Non-Proliferation Treaty in New York, endorsed the indefinite extension of that basic agreement as a guarantee for maintaining and strengthening global security and stability. Thus, the decision adopted at the Conference on the indefinite extension of the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons is fully in accordance with the objectives of Kazakhstan's international policy.
