REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF AN ADDITIONAL ITEM IN THE AGENDA OF THE SEVENTEENTH SESSION

QUESTION OF GENERAL AND COMPLETE DISARMAMENT: REPORT OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE EIGHTEEN-NATION COMMITTEE ON DISARMAMENT

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Conference of the Eighteen-Nation Committee on Disarmament on 7 September 1962 adopted a "Report to the United Nations" for transmission to the United Nations Disarmament Commission and to the seventeenth session of the General Assembly.^{1/} This report was described as a second interim progress report on the Conference deliberations for the period 1 June 1962 to 8 September 1962.
2. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 1722 (XVI) the Conference had previously submitted a progress report to the Disarmament Commission on 31 May 1962 covering the period 14 March to 1 June 1962 (DC/203).
3. Following the submission of the second interim progress report, the Secretary-General has the honour to request the inclusion of the following item in the agenda of the seventeenth session of the General Assembly: "Question of general and complete disarmament: report of the Conference of the Eighteen-Nation Committee on Disarmament."
