Statement on the Turkish incursion into Iraq, issued on 16 May 1997 by the Presidency of the European Union

The Presidency of the European Union notes with concern the fact that the Turkish armed forces have once again entered northern Iraq. Notwithstanding its understanding of the Turkish wish to end terrorist actions, the Presidency of the European Union stresses that a solution to the Kurdish problem can only be achieved politically, not militarily. It calls on Turkey to exercise the utmost restraint, to respect human rights, not to endanger the lives of innocent civilians and to withdraw its military forces from Iraqi territory as soon as possible.
