<u>Strasbourg joint statement by the Presidents of</u> <u>Azerbaijan and Armenia dated 10 October 1997</u>

[Original: Russian]

Azerbaijan and Armenia remain committed to a peaceful settlement of the Nagorny Karabakh conflict by political means, in the first place through negotiations.

Azerbaijan and Armenia believe that the framework of the Minsk Group and the activity of the Co-Chairmen of the Minsk Conference are aimed at establishing a basis which, with a constructive attitude by all the parties involved in the conflict, would make it possible to achieve real progress in the settlement of the conflict.

Azerbaijan and Armenia believe that the latest proposals of the Co-Chairmen are an encouraging basis for the resumption of negotiations within the framework of the Minsk Group.
