(a) Brochures/fliers	Produced in consultation with the Department of Peacekeeping Operations, the United Nations Institute for Disarmament Research, the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons and the Preparatory Commission for the Comprehensive Nuclear Test-Ban Treaty Organization
(b) Documentary film on small arms
