Decree No. 628 of 4 December 1997 by the President of the Republic of Belarus on the extension of the moratorium on the export of anti-personnel landmines

In order to promote international efforts to achieve the goal of eliminating anti-personnel mines, I hereby decide:

- 1. To extend until the end of 1999 the moratorium on the export of all types of anti-personnel landmines, declared in accordance with Decree No. 335 of 22 August 1995 by the President of the Republic of Belarus on the introduction in the Republic of Belarus of a moratorium on the export of anti-personnel landmines.
- 2. The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus shall take measures to ensure the implementation of the moratorium declared.
 - 3. This Decree shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
