Financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First
Committee (A/5303)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 952nd meeting on 20 November 1962, the Fifth Committee considered the financial implications of the draft resolution submitted by the First Committee on the question of general and complete disarmament (A/5303, paragraph 10). For its consideration, the Committee had before it a report of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/948) as well as a related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, which was presented orally by the Acting Chairman of that Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee would call for an appropriation, under section 2 of the 1963 budget, estimated at a total amount of \$837,900, and that offsetting revenue to an estimated amount of \$90,000 would accrue from the application of staff assessment to the salaries of the temporary staff which would have to be engaged.
