Financial implications of the draft resolution proposed by the First
Committee (A/5341)

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. N.A. QUAO (Ghana)

1. In accordance with rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee considered, at its 974th meeting on 13 December 1962, the financial implications of the draft resolution proposed by the First Committee (A/5341, para. 8).
2. For the consideration of this item, the Committee had before it reports of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/961) and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/5345).
3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution contained in document A/5341 would not give rise to additional expenditure in 1963, provided that meetings of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and its Sub-Committee were held exclusively at Headquarters and that only normal servicing requirements were provided. Were such assumptions not realized, the Secretary-General would seek the prior concurrence of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions with a view to incurring the necessary expenditure under the terms of the resolution relating to unforeseen and extraordinary expenses for the financial year 1963, and any additional provision in cover of such expenditure would be included in the Secretary-General's supplementary estimates for 1963.
