PROVISIONAL AGENDA OF THE EIGHTEENTH SESSION

DENUCLEARIZATION OF LATIN AMERICA

Letter dated 18 July 1963 from the Deputy Permanent Representative
of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

With reference to the decision taken by the General Assembly on 19 December 1962 that consideration of the draft resolution submitted by Bolivia, Brazil, Chile and Ecuador on the denuclearization of Latin America (document A/C.1/L.312/Rev.2) be postponed to the eighteenth session of the General Assembly, I have the honour to request that an item entitled "Denuclearization of Latin America" be included in the provisional agenda of the eighteenth session of the General Assembly.

An explanatory memorandum will follow shortly.
